If it has been a while since you've used the bus or train, here's what you need to know.

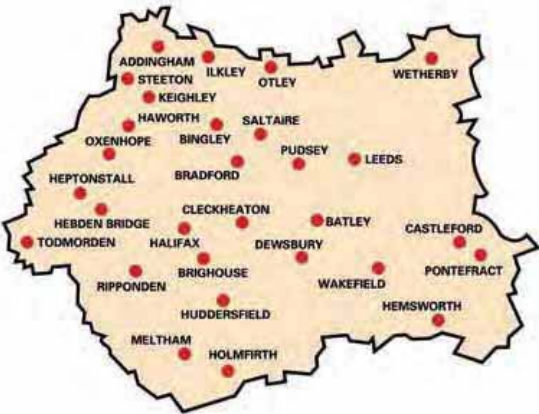
Catching the bus

For buses, we hope that by making use of our information services, such as MetroLine, you will know which bus stop you need for your journey. The bus stop will often list destinations and have timetables on display.

- When you see your bus approaching, put your hand out to show the driver that you want the bus to stop.
- When you get on, buy your single or return ticket from the driver, or show your season ticket.
- When approaching the stop where you want to get off, please press the bell to let the driver know.

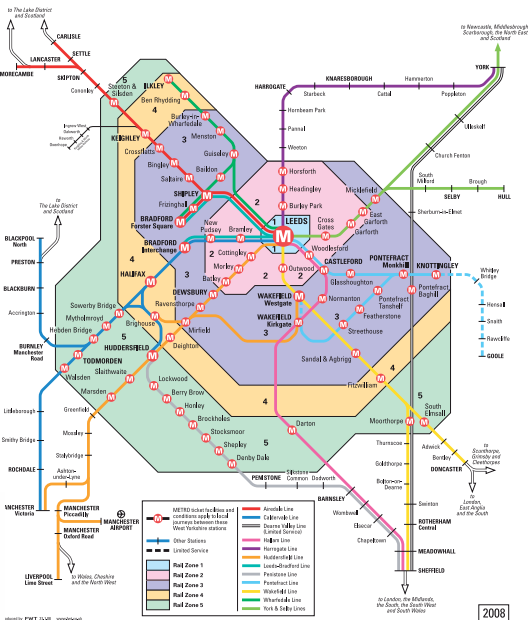
Buses in West Yorkshire

Catching the train

Trains are easy to catch – if they are timetabled to stop at a station, they will stop there. You don't need to put out your hand. The map below shows all the rail stations throughout West Yorkshire.

MetroLine

Available on 0113 245 7676 from 7am to 10pm every day of the year except Christmas Day, Boxing Day and New Year's Day, MetroLine's advisers can provide you with detailed information on West Yorkshire bus & train journeys and times.

Travel Centres

You can get face-to-face travel advice at Metro's four Travel Centres. Located at Bradford Interchange, Halifax, Huddersfield and Leeds Bus Stations. Travel Centres are open from Monday to Saturday.



Real-time bus information

Metro's **yournextbus** service can be accessed by text, WAP or internet.

Text message

Step 1: Create a message on your mobile.

Step 2: Text the eight-digit bus stop number, shown on the bus stop, to **63876** (this spells METRO).

Step 3: Your returned text will tell you a real-time prediction of how many minutes away the bus is, or will give you scheduled information (this will appear as 24-hour clock time).

WAP and internet

Step 1: For **WAP** access visit m.wymetro.com and for access via a **PC** visit www.wymetro.com

Step 2: Navigate to the real-time information box on the right to enter in your bus stop number or select 'more search options' to find your bus stop if you don't know it. You can find the bus stop using either the service number or location.

Step 3: Bus departure information for the next hour's departures will be shown and it will refresh every 60 seconds. Real-time predictions appear in minutes and scheduled information appears as a 24-hour clock time.

Handy tip: if you use this bus stop regularly, bookmark the real-time page to access it quickly.
